DEVELOPMENTALLY APPROPRIATE PRACTICE

Developmentally appropriate curriculum is based on the premise that play is the primary medium through which children learn. This learning in young children is a result of interaction between a child's thoughts, and experiences with materials ideas and people. These experiences should match the child's interests and understanding.



We at Next Horizons strive to create an atmosphere and environment in which the child may explore the world. Familiarity with growth patterns enables staff to plan a program that is developmentally as well as individually appropriate for each child.. We also believe that an important function of a childcare center is to provide service, support, and assistance to parents to help with the everyday challenges of parenting.

RATIOS

Next Horizons follows the guidelines from the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) regarding adult to child ratios. We believe that the relationship between child and caregiver/teacher is the basis for a positive child-care experience. Next Horizons uses a primary caregiver model for infants and toddlers. The pre-school rooms have a lead teacher who is assisted by other full-time teachers. Keeping our ratios low gives group care a home-like feel with the advantages of a center-based social climate and learning experience. The infant room has a ratio of one caregiver for every three infants. In the toddler rooms the ratio is one-to-four, and in the preschool one-to-six.

QUALIFIED STAFF

Caregivers and teachers at Next Horizons are experienced and highly qualified. Our staff turnover is low ensuring continuity of care and consistency of staffing. Staff members receive ongoing training in child development through workshops, speakers, and trainings.

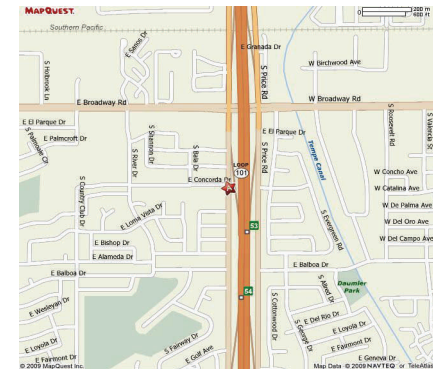

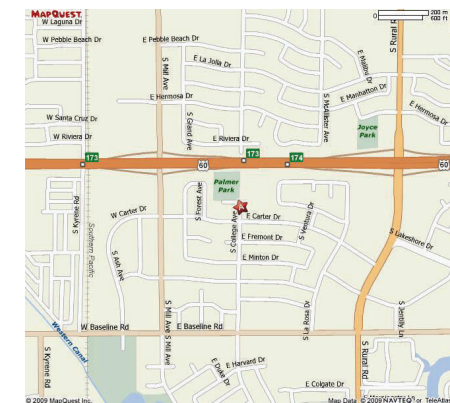
